

Chokhatauri Municipality

Geographical and Statistical Data

The municipality is an administrative and territorial unit in the Guria region of Georgia. Chokhatauri is the most mountainous town in the region of Guria.

The population within the municipality is 24, 903. Most of the population is Orthodox Christians with a small Muslim minority. It includes one town and sixty-one villages.

Local Self-Government

The supreme body of the local municipality is the Council of Chokhatauri Municipality. The head of the municipality is the chief executive of the Board of the Chokhatauri Municipality.

Education and Culture

There are 31 public schools and one private school in the town. The municipality provides non-formal education for the local youth such as music, art, youth house, and sport education as well as providing nine libraries and museums.

Youth Development

The municipality cooperates with the Peace Corps Georgia office and will work for many more years with American volunteers to improve youth related issues and support innovative projects within the community.

One of the latest innovative projects from the municipality is serving the youth in the mountainous regions to provide free transportation services for non-formal education opportunities in the town center.

The municipality cooperates with various national and international youth development organizations.
