A. NON-FORMAL AND INFORMAL LEARNING BASED ON CREATIVITY

Developing and promoting youth work as an approach to implement active learning.

B. YOUTH WORK AND LIFE TRANSITIONS

Youth is a period of many transitions such as moving from dependence on parents/ family to autonomy. Youth work offers opportunity and support in transition from education and training to life, citizenship and the labour market.

D. LEARNING IN YOUTH WORK: VOLUNTEERING OPPORTUNITIES AS A FIRST STEP TO BECOME ACTIVE

What's the relation between volunteering, youth work and employability?

Non-formal learning programs from municipalities.

Special presentation: 20th anniversary of European Voluntary Service.

E. THE PRIORITY OF YOUTH WORK TODAY: CREATE OPPORTUNITIES TO LEARNING BY DOING

On why learning by doing approaches are especially important today.
